



NT Field Naturalists' Club: Field trip COVID-19 Safety Plan

Physical distancing and hygiene measures will be communicated to participants before the event via the Club's website and to participants in a briefing at the start of the event:

- Anyone with respiratory symptoms will be asked not to participate.
- A COVID-19 awareness talk will be given at the start of proceedings.
- A list of all participants and their contact details will be recorded and retained. In the event that someone in the group is later diagnosed with COVID-19, the president and delegated committee members will undertake to contact all participants as advised by health authorities.
- All participants will be strongly encouraged to have the COVIDSafe app installed and activated on their phones
- Hand washing and/or hand sanitising equipment will be made available, all attendees will be encouraged to use these at the start of the event.
- All participants will be asked to maintain 1.5 metres distance from other participants other than household contacts or friends who have travelled to the event with them.
- All participants will be asked to bring their own, and not share, drinks and other refreshments
- All participants will be asked not to share binoculars and other equipment except with household contacts or friends who have travelled to the event with them
- A first aid kit will be carried, this will include facemasks and gloves for use by those rendering assistance
- Event leaders will monitor appropriate distancing during the event and remind participants as necessary.
- If there is concern that a participant shows symptoms that could be related to COVID-19 infection, the organisers will seek advice from the NT COVID-19 Hotline on **1800 008 002**.

These procedures will be followed in subsequent Field Trips.
